Ndinawemaaganag Endaawaad Inc. is currently seeking **casual** Youth Workers for Chu Manitou Tanka Oyati Tipi second stage house. The program provides a safe, nurturing home for youth to develop the skills and capacities to become independent as they transition to adulthood.

The Youth Workers primary duties include:

- Provide supervision to up to 12 youth residing in the program
- Provide resource information, complete referrals and act as an advocate for youth upon request to youth and their families.
- Ensure appropriate documentation as required. This includes logbook entries, MAR forms, incident reports
- Build positive and supportive relationships with youth
- Act a positive role model and provide mentorship to youth.
- Respond to and manage crisis situations as they arise
- Maintain appropriate documentation

Qualifications:

- A combination of related education and employment experience, with particular experience with residential care.
- Strong understanding of and sensitivity to the issues that impact urban Aboriginal youth with particular emphasis on high risk, street involved youth.
- Demonstrated understanding of the Child Protection Act and Licensing requirements.
- Strong motivational and leadership skills.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Strong time management skills.
- Able to maintain a high level of independence and self-initiative.
- Ability to work under stressful conditions.
- Valid Driver’s License
- Subject to Criminal, Prior Contact, and Child Abuse Registry Checks.
